## **CROMER CARNIVAL PROCESSION 2026**

### **Rules and conditions of entry for floats taking part in the procession**

1. **NO Persons** must be transported To and From the Carnival field on the back of the float – Persons may only ride on the float during the Carnival parade - **This is the Responsibility of the Driver.**
2. All floats and entries taking part in the Carnival Parade please enter via the gateway to The Carnival Field (*Not the NNDC Car Park entrance*).
3. Consumption of alcohol or drugs by any person whilst taking part in the parade is forbidden. Drink driving laws apply and the police will take action against offenders.
4. Nothing is to be thrown from floats. This includes liquids and sweets. Failure to comply will result in you being excluded from the parade.
5. No Person Under the Age of 17 years old and not holding a FULL Driving licence is permitted to drive any type of vehicle in the Parade. Failure to comply will result in you being excluded from the parade.
6. All float organisers are reminded that motorised vehicles must fully comply with the requirements of The Road Traffic Act 1988.
7. All float organisers are reminded that they must hold a valid Public Liability Insurance for their float display,
8. All floats are required to make sure that their entry is not too wide to go through the town.
9. The safety of all persons riding on floats is the responsibility of the respective float organiser and driver of the float vehicle. The Carnival Committee and Cromer V.E.O Ltd cannot be held liable for any accident to any person taking part in the Carnival Procession, unless that accident is the direct result of action by a member of the Carnival Committee or authorised helper, providing such Committee member or helper is on duty at the time the instruction was given.
10. Collecting in the Parade can only be made by Official Cromer Carnival Collectors, No other fund raising for any other Charity is permitted
11. ALL Floats MUST start and Finish on the Carnival Field,
12. UK Road Traffic Act laws apply. Applicants must ensure that all drivers hold (and are not disqualified from holding) a licence to drive the class of vehicle used and drive/ride that vehicle in accordance with current UK legislation. Vehicles must be taxed and it is the responsibility of the entrants to ensure that all vehicles being driven have a minimum of third party insurance cover. Road vehicles must be fully licenced and MOT tested (if applicable) in accordance with current UK legislation for that type of vehicle.
13. No horses will be allowed in the parade.
14. All entrants must be in the carnival spirit; we do not accept entries that are purely advertising.
15. All entrants must without exception comply with event marshals or the parade organisers instructions and conduct themselves in a manner that will neither inconvenience nor endanger any other person or exhibit at any time.
