Cross Cabbell Road and turn right along it

- 11. Someone is hoping for good luck. What and Where? Lucky cat No.33

Turn left

Turn left and cross the road at zebra crossing. Turn left and then right

Turn left down the Gangway

- 33. What's the grid reference for the best views in town? 52° 55' 52.788"N 1° 18' 12.8484" E Whitewater

(Public toilets in the Rocket House)

Follow promenade round to the left

- 34. How long to make a delivery? **20 minutes**
- 35. Since when have you been able to ride the waves? **2007 Surf School**
- 36. Who gives you permission to be here? NNDC
- 37. The coastguard kept watch from here. Where? The Old Lookout

Continue along promenade

Turn left and go up the slope

Turn right along the clifftop path
