

## Cromer Carnival Treasure Hunt 2026

Here are the answers

**Out of main door of Cliftonville Hotel and turn right then right again**

1. The pier is 125 years old this year, which house is five years older? **No.4 Ocean View**
2. Ready for the rain – or sun? Who? Where? **Statue of girl with umbrella at No.22**

**Walk to the top of the road and cross over to left**

3. These are numbered - which is this one? **Post Box NR27 2726D**

**Follow the footpath on the left hand side, downhill and turn left at the bottom**

4. You need a code for your location? What is it? **34863 at car park**

**At the end of the road turn right and walk towards the town**

5. How do you get in here? Where? How? **Anglia Court – Entrance at the rear**

**Cross Runton Road at the zebra crossing, turn right and follow clifftop path**

6. They commemorate the millennium. What? How many? **Benches with 2000 - 3**
7. How long will it take you to get to a lift? **7 minutes (sign post at top of slope)**

**Turn left down the slope**

8. They finish work at 6pm. Who? **Lifeguards**

**Turn right along promenade**

9. How much does it cost to make the perfect sandcastle? **£4 for a castle bucket**
10. It's Showtime! Where? **Crazy Fun House**
11. When did John Taylor visit? **1623**
12. What does the chequered flag indicate? **Surfboard and watercraft zone**

**Turn left onto the pier and walk round in a clockwise direction**

13. All the fun of the fair. Where? **Neuilly (Painting)**
14. You can't you catch a train here. Why not? **Crustacean station**
15. They are going to have a house party. Who? When? **The Irish September 27<sup>th</sup>**
16. You didn't have to do this, but in 1960 how many people paid to do what? **Over 100,000 paid to go through the turnstiles**

**Off the pier and turn left**

17. This goes on sand and in water? What? How? **Beach wheelchair - pneumatic tyres**
18. Are you having fun? Who didn't? When? **Winston Churchill 1885**
19. Not in the sky but it will help you in the water? **Star float in the sea**

**Keep straight ahead along the promenade**

20. Not fishing for crabs but for what? **Litter (bin for fishermen's litter)**
21. Good advice but don't forget the sunscreen? What? Where? **Keep calm and sun bathe at Cromer – sign at Hut No.19**
22. Same advice here. What number? **Hut 47 has same sign**
23. What will you learn about if you scan here? **QR code for Safer Seals Project**

**Turn right up the zig-zag slope – At top turn left then immediately right**

24. Who is missed, admired and remembered? **Tony West (bench)**

**Go into the park on the right and go straight ahead across the grass**

25. They look after the wildflower area? Who? **Cromer Green Spaces**

26. A shapely flower bed. What is it? **Crab**

**Turn left towards park gates**

27. How big was the field? **2½ acres (on sign about sale of land)**

**Turn right**

28. How do they recruit? Who? On what? **Caremark – On personality**

**Go straight ahead, cross at traffic lights and turn right**

29. What does the 2 chilli guide indicate? **Nice 'n' Spicy (Bann Thai restaurant)**

30. Sounds like a sweet but you drink it. What? Where? **Rhubarb and custard white hot chocolate - Fika East**

31. More chequered flags - whose logo? **Tiny's Taxis**

**Turn left**

32. Look at the furniture but don't take a rest here? Where? Why not? **Cromer Trading Centre – "Please don't sit on the ledge"**

33. Small diamonds? Where? **Little Gems**

**Cross the road to ... (Lots of traffic be careful)**

34. ... to where they sell small furniture? Where? **The Dolls House Shop**

**Cross to left hand pavement**

35. They can help you get ready for winter. Who? **Bure Valley Woodburners (sign at Launderette)**

36. A good yarn here? Where? **Wool and Crafts shop**

**Turn left**

37. The only morning paper published in Norfolk. What is it? Where could you buy it? **Eastern Daily Press – Mondays (Strand House)**

38. What can you do if you are a member? **Save More - at Superdrug**

39. What is their priority? Who? What? **Your Health – at Cromer Pharmacy**

**Cross the road at the pedestrian crossing**

40. This will help you get in. What? Where? **Assisted door at Boots**

41. The cure for anything. What? Where? **Salt water – Sign at Gift shop)**

**Turn right**

42. It's slowly going uphill. What? Where? **Snail on window ledge at No.8**

43. Who is there for your 24/7? **Co-Op funeral directors**

44. They sell posh ice cream here. Where? What? **Pungleperrys - Artisan Gelato**

45. For fourteen years he did this job. Who? What was it? **Lewis "Tuna" Harrison- Coxswain No.2 Lifeboat**

**urn left (Take care - narrow pavement)**

46. They eat the pages. What? **Bookworms**

47. A retired Captain may live here. Where? **Skippers Rest No.19**

**Cross the road and go onto clifftop path**

48. What was first recorded in 1390? **The pier (on history board near top of steps)**

**At end of sunken gardens turn left then right onto putting green path**

**Down the steps then cross the road back to the start (Main road so be careful)**
